

Breast Pump is a KanCare Medicaid covered benefit.

A member doesn't have to be part of Healthy First Steps (uhcbabyblocks.com) to get a Breast Pump.

KMAP for Kansas DME:

E0602 - manual breast pump

E0603 - (breast pump, electric

These are covered but not more than one total per year

The following breast pump replacement parts are limited to no more than two of each per year:

A4281- Replacement breast pump tube

A4282 - Adapter for breast pump, replacement

A4283 - Cap for breast pump bottle, replacement

A4285 - Polycarbonate bottle for use with breast pump, replacement

A4286 - Locking ring for breast pump, replacement

Non-covered breast pumps and accessories:

E0604 - Hospital grade breast pump is **not covered**

A4284 - Breast shield and splash protector for use with breast pump, replacement

Members can order their breast pumps in advance, and receive it several weeks prior to the estimated due date.
