Palliative Care in Kansas

The availability of palliative care in Kansas varies by community – hospice, outpatient, clinical, nursing facilities and even a partnership with care facilities to receive palliative care.

If you think you or your loved one could benefit from palliative care, talk to your health care provider.

Let Us Help You

We never know how to start, palliative care isn't – palliative care occurs at all levels, from a clear treatment for your illness and does not depend upon the course of your illness.

Palliative care teams sometimes do not focus on taking long or difficult. Consider these questions when planning:

- What do I understand about my illness and treatment?
- What treatments and programs are available? Is palliative care an "add-on" service?
- What are the most important goals of treatment now and in the future?
