## Did you pack?

- Pump parts (flanges, tubing, valves, membrane), extra set if possible
- Breast milk storage bags/containers and oen to label
- Healthy snacks and water bottle
- Wipes to clean pumps parts
- Waterproof bag to put pump parts in for cleaning later
