Continue to breastfeed.• If breastfeeding isn't an option, sterilize pump parts in boiling water.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use liquid, ready-to-use infant formula.• Prepare powdered formula with bottled or boiled water.• Boil water for at least 1 minute.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Wash and sterilize bottles and nipples before use.• If you cannot sterilize bottles, try single-serve, ready-to-feed bottles.
