- Plan and/or place for parents to breastfeed their child onsite that is NOT a restroom
- Centers Enroll in Breastfeeding Welcome Here program to display window decals and table tents in public spaces
- Training
 - Refer to free course at KCCTO (see above) or host an in-person training (contact KBC at info@ksbreastfeeding.org)
 - Include breastfeeding information in other trainings (CACFP, safe sleep, infant nutrition, infant and toddler development, learning environments), emergency preparedness, etc.) see KBC for content
 - Offer online training options and "off-camera" options during trainings to support breastfeeding students
